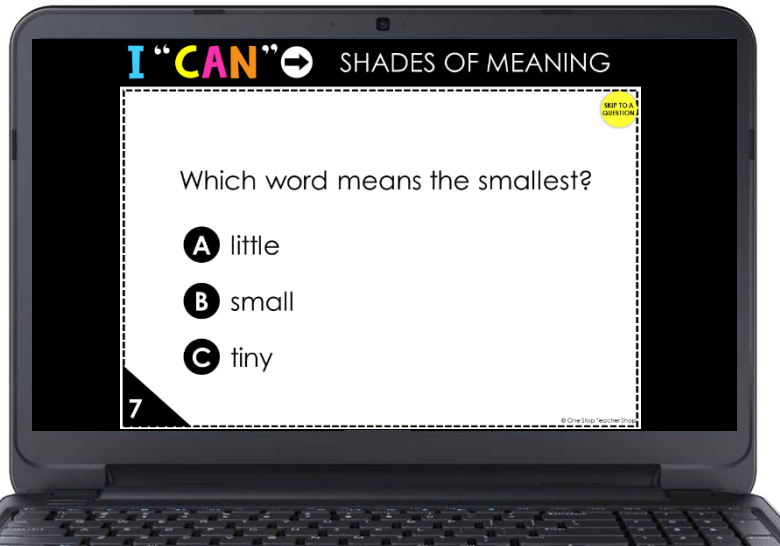
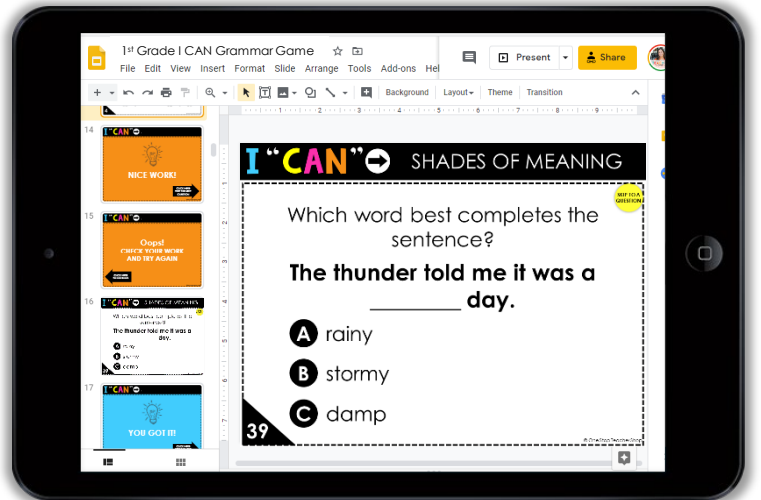

HOW TO PLAY

IN A GROUP OF 2 OR MORE...

1. Start with the first question, ALL players will solve each question on their own and write their answer down (don't let anyone see your answer).
2. Player 1 will select the answer they think is correct.
3. If they get it right, player 1 gets a point and it is now Player 2's turn.
4. If player 1 is incorrect, the next player can try to steal the point by selecting the correct answer.
5. If no one gets the question correct, the question is skipped.
6. Player 2's turn starts with the next question.
7. The player with the most points wins!

2. If you get the question correct, you get the question wrong.
3. Mark your answer on the answer sheet.

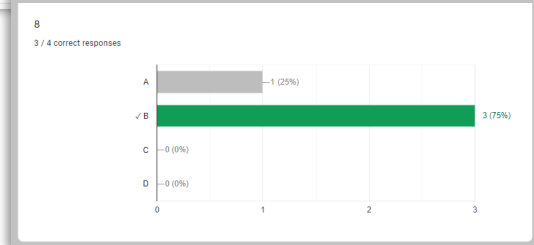

FREQUENTLY ASKS QUESTIONS

QUESTION: Do I need a special program to use these games?

ANSWER: Yes! You must have access to PowerPoint (free app is fine) or Google Slides on the device you plan to use.

QUESTION: What devices are these games compatible with?

ANSWER: Because I'm including a version for PowerPoint and Google Slides (Google Forms, too) these game will work with ANY device & operating system (tablets, computers, phones, Apple, PC, etc.), as long as you have access to Google Drive and/or PowerPoint (free apps are available).

QUESTION: Once I purchase this resource, how will I get the digital I CAN Math Games?

ANSWER: Immediately after you make your purchase, you will download a PDF that contains links to ALL of the games (Google Slides & Google Forms). Simply chose the Game you want to use, click the link provided, and it will be added to your Google Drive. PowerPoint files are already included in the folder.

QUESTION: Can I use these with Google Classroom or other online learning platforms?
